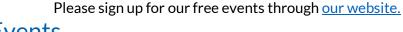

NEW PROGRAM WITH CAMP QUALITY

Camp Goodtimes is very excited to announce the launch of a new program for our young adults this coming spring! Starting in April 2020, Camp Goodtimes will be running a chapter of Camp Quality's Breaking Borders Program in British Columbia. Breaking Borders is a participant-led experience for young adult survivors of childhood cancer aged 19 to 25 years old that culminates in a multi-day outdoor adventure. The expedition is planned entirely from the ground up by the group who take part including where we go and what to do. We hope this program promotes self-confidence, independence, and resiliency whilst creating authentic connections amongst their peer group.
