Big & Little Sloth Pins

Materials

- Cardboard/Paper
- Markers/Paint
- Clothespins (x4)
- Black Marker
- Glue



Instructions



1. Using your cardboard or paper, cut out the shape of your big and little sloth body. You want your sloths to have a body and head

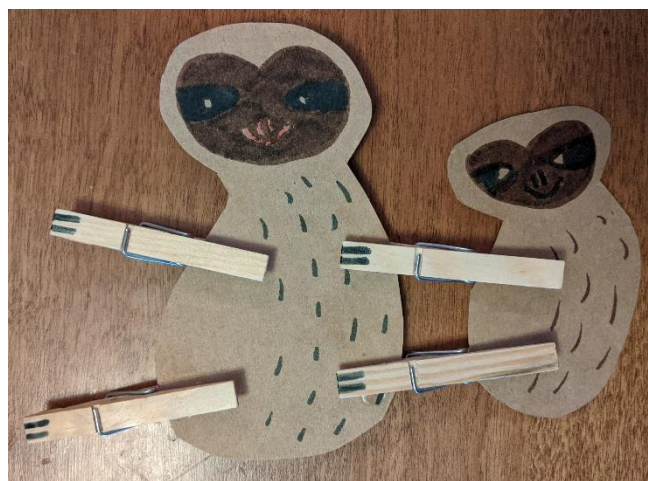
2. Draw your face onto your sloths. You can also cut out other pieces of paper to glue on to your sloth bodies if that works better

3. Time to add the feet and hands. Glue the end you use to open the clothespin with to your sloth body so that the body is on the inside of the clothespin. Glue two clothespin to your sloth a little ways apart to make their arms and legs.



4. On the other part of the clothespin not glued to the body you can use black marker to draw on their little fingers and toes

5. Now bring your sloths anywhere you choose! But remember, they go in pairs
