CRAFT: UNDERWATER FLASHLIGHT

Have you ever wanted to be a scuba diver and look at all the wonders under the sea? Now is your chance! Draw your own underwater or deep sea scene with what you would want to see underwater then create a special flashlight that lets you illuminate the sea!

Materials

- Freezer Sized Ziploc Bag
- Permanent Markers
- 1 piece of black construction paper
- White Paper
- Scissors



Instructions



1. You can slip the white piece of paper inside your Ziploc bag so you can see better while you colour your underwater scene!
2. Colour on top of your Ziploc bag your underwater scene. Do you want to see octopus? Crabs? Treasure? Unlike the pictures shown here, the bottom of your scene should run along the Ziploc part of the bag

3. Take your white sheet of paper out of the Ziploc bag and slide in the piece of black construction paper into the bag

4. Using your white piece of paper, draw a flashlight with a beam of light coming out of it. You can colour the base of the flashlight but leave the beam of light as white. Your flashlight beam should be about half the length of your Ziploc bag

5. Now use your special flashlight to light up your underwater scene by sliding your flashlight inside your Ziploc bag on top of the black piece of paper and watch the water come to life!
