A Bug's Life: Egg Carton Bugs

In 2018, our theme for summer was A Bug's Life! We welcomed Flik, Atta, and the whole bug circus to camp and even helped them chase away Hopper by building a bird! We're going to recreate one of our crafts from this theme using egg cartons, paint, pipe cleaners, and some inspiration from our favourite bug circus!



Materials

- Cardboard Egg Carton
- Paint
- Pipe Cleaners
- Scissors
- Optional: markers, googly eyes, glue, toothpick

Instructions

1. Choose which character you would like to build from A Bug's Life. Use a row of three for Flik or Atta, the whole row for Heimlich, and a row of 2 for Francis. OR! Make your own bug!
2. Once you have cut your egg carton, paint your row in the colour of your character: green for Heimlich, blue for Flik, purple for Atta, and black/red for Francis. Or go wild and create your very own new bug
3. Once your paint has dried, glue on your googly eyes or use a marker to draw on eyes
4. Use scissors or a toothpick to poke holes in your egg carton for where you want your antennas and legs to go. Use the spaces in between each egg container to put your legs
5. Add any finishing touches to your bug! Maybe add wings? Maybe add polka dots or stripes?
6. And voila! Your own pet bug.
