2019 Outer Space: Toilet Paper Roll Aliens

Last summer, we welcomed in Plutonians, gazed at the stars, completed astronaut training, and envisioned what life would be like if we could take to aliens. In this week's arts & crafts throwback, we will be upcycling some toilet paper rolls to create our own aliens!



Materials

- Toilet Paper Roll
- Paint/Markers
- Pipe Cleaners and/or PomPoms
- Googly Eyes
- Glue or Hot Glue
- Paper
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Paint or colour in your toilet paper roll to whatever colours you want your alien to be
2. Once your paint has dried, add some arms and feet to your alien
 - a. Use pipe cleaners as arms by making hole in the side of your toilet paper roll and insert as many arms as you want. If you want, cut out little hands from your paper and glue them to the ends of your pipe cleaner
 - b. Make feet for your alien out of paper and glue them to the bottom of your toilet paper roll
3. Add the finishing touches to your alien by adding eyes and hair
 - a. Eyes can be glued on to the paper roll directly or onto pipe cleaners attached to the inside top of the toilet paper roll
 - b. Use yarn or paper or a coffee filter cut up to add hair
4. And done! Maybe make one or five aliens to make an alien troupe!
