

## CAMP GOODTIMES IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT GUIDELINES

Please check this list and note the immunizations that apply to you based on when you were born. Please consult with your doctor or a public health unit **as soon as possible**.

Children who are currently receiving active cancer treatment or who have a medical condition preventing them from receiving immunizations are exempt. Please speak to our Camp Goodtimes, Clinical Coordinator at any time to discuss.

### Tetanus-Diphtheria or Tetanus-Diphtheria with Acellular Pertussis (DTAp)

ONLY Option	You have proof of a primary series (2 doses) of Tdap or DTAp vaccine and a booster every 10 years
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### Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)

Year of Birth	Measles	Mumps	Rubella	MMR vaccine - combined
Prior to 1957	0 doses	0 doses	1 dose	1 dose
1957-1969	2 doses	1 dose		2 doses
1970+		2 doses		

Option 1	You have proof of a primary series (2 doses as noted birth year above) of MMR vaccine
Option 2	You have a blood test (titer) showing the measles IgG antibody result and rubella IgG antibody result

### Varicella (Chickenpox)

Option 1	You had chickenpox after 12 months of age (when you were older than 1 year)
Option 2	You have proof of a primary series (2 doses) of the varicella vaccine
Option 3	You have a blood test (titer) showing the varicella IgG antibody result

### Hepatitis B (required if born after 1980)

Option 1	You have proof of a primary series (3 doses) of the hepatitis B vaccine
Option 2	You have a blood test (titer) showing a hepatitis B immunity result



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### COVID 19 (highly recommended not mandatory)

ONLY Option	Vaccine History	Primary Series (2 doses)	+ Booster as qualified. Please provide proof of most recent vaccine within 6 months of camp start date if available.
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### Influenza Vaccine (highly recommended no mandatory)

ONLY Option	Vaccine History	Annual Please provide proof of most recent vaccine within 1 year of camp start date if available.
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Please note that some vaccines have a period of waiting before they are effective at preventing disease; we require that you complete the immunizations, including any waiting period prior to attending Camp.
