Children who are <u>currently receiving active cancer treatment</u> or who have a medical condition preventing them from receiving immunizations are exempt. Please speak to our Camp Goodtimes, Clinical Coordinator at any time to discuss.

Tetanus-Diphtheria or Tetanus-Diphtheria with Acellular Pertussis (DTAp)

Varicella (Chickenpox)

Option 1	You had chickenpox after 12 months of age (when you were older than 1 year)	
Option 2	You have proof of a primary series (2 doses) of the varicella vaccine	
Option 3	You have a blood test (titer) showing the varicella IgG antibody result	

Hepatitis B (required if born after 1980)

Option 1	You have proof of a primary series (3 doses) of the hepatitis B vaccine
Option 2	You have a blood test (titer) showing a hepatitis B immunity result
