


THE BEAN NEWSLETTER - WINTER 2024

40 YEARS OF CAMP GOODTIMES!

An idea to create a camp for children with cancer was spearheaded by long-time Canadian Cancer Society volunteer Louis Youngson. In 1985, led by Youngson and an energetic committee of volunteers, a pilot summer camp program called Camp Goodtimes was launched which served 25 children in its first year.

Fast forward 40 years later to 2025, and Camp Goodtimes has grown to serve nearly 600 children, teens, and family members with a workforce of over 100 volunteers each summer!

We have exciting things planned for 2025 to celebrate this very special milestone. To kick things off we are happy to announce our 40 Years of Camp Goodtimes #throwbackthursday campaign!
