Step 1: Check-out campgoodtimes.org!

Step 2: Apply!

- Follow the link to apply from our website.
- Please note that you will need to fill out a form for each individual attending camp the more information that you are able to provide to us during this process, the better we will be able to accommodate you at camp this summer!
 - Please be prepared to provide care card numbers, and emergency contacts!
- Applications are open until March 31, 2026. Priority is given to applicants receiving active
 treatment and first-time participants. We encourage eligible participants to apply to their
 program of choice. We work hard to make sure our applicants can have at least one camp
 experience each summer.
- If you are a new user, please go ahead and create a "New User Sign-Up"

Step 3: Upload immunization records!

- All participants, including caregivers at family camp, must provide <u>proof of up-to-date</u> <u>childhood immunizations</u>. We encourage you to start this process as soon as possible as records can be difficult to track down in some cases.

Step 4: New camper welcome call!

- If you are a new family or camper joining us at camp this summer, please expect a phone call from someone on the Camp Goodtimes team within 2 weeks of your application.
